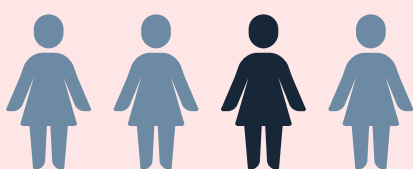




Pregnancy Loss Statistics

On average it takes

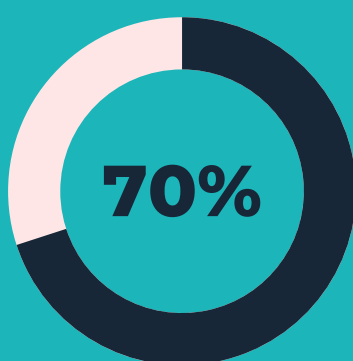
4-6 weeks

for your period to resume after miscarriage

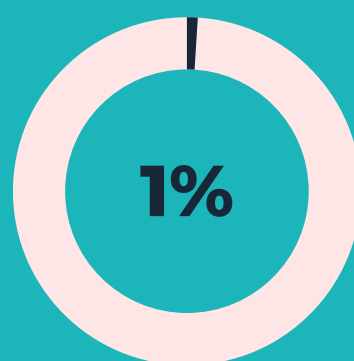

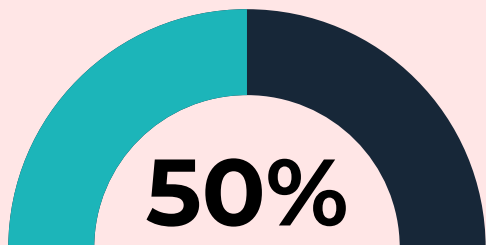
of miscarriages happen in the 1st trimester



of miscarriages are related to chromosomal issues

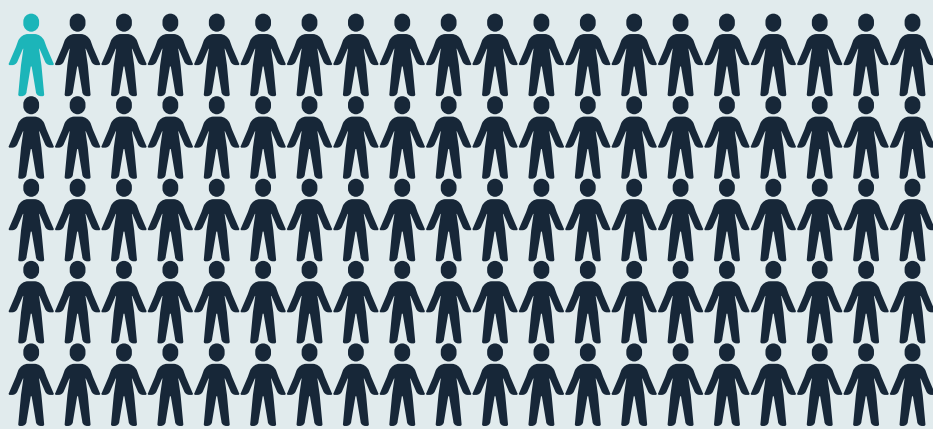


of pregnancy-carrying people experience recurrent pregnancy loss

RISK FACTORS



BMI of 30+ increases risk of miscarriage



People 35+ are at greater risk for miscarriage

Autoimmune issues and preexisting conditions impact risk



Alcohol and street drugs have been shown to increase risk
